8 On page 6 after line 25, insert the following  
9 section and renumber accordingly:

10 Section 6. (a) Effective with the license year  
11 beginning September 1, 2014, nonresidents of any state, in  
12 lieu of any otherwise required fishing licenses, may procure a  
13 nonresident three (3) day individual fishing license, for a  
14 period of three (3) consecutive days or less by paying a  
15 license fee of thirteen dollars and fifty cents (\$13.50) to  
16 fish in any of the otherwise legally available freshwaters of  
17 this state during those hours occurring the then current  
18 license year for a period not to exceed 72 consecutive hours  
19 from the beginning date and time, as selected and designated  
20 by the licensee to the issuing agent at the time of issuance.  
21 This licensing fee shall be subject to adjustment as provided  
22 for in Section 9-11-68, Code of Alabama.

23 (b) Effective with the license year beginning  
24 September 1, 2014, nonresidents of any state, in lieu of any  
25 otherwise required fishing licenses, may procure a nonresident  
26 three (3) day individual fishing license for a period of three  
27 (3) consecutive days or less by paying a licensing fee of

1 thirteen dollars and fifty cents (\$13.50) to fish in any of  
2 the otherwise legally available saltwaters of this state  
3 during those hours occurring during the then current license  
4 year for a period not to exceed 72 consecutive hours from the  
5 beginning date and time, as selected and designated by the  
6 licensee to the issuing agent at the time of issuance. This  
7 licensing fee shall be subject to adjustment as provided for  
8 in Section 9-11-69, Code of Alabama 1975.

9 (c) All licensing fees collected pursuant in  
10 subsections (a) and (b) shall be distributed half (1/2) to the  
11 Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources and  
12 half (1/2) to the Alabama Bass Trail.
