8 SYNOPSIS:

9 This bill would prohibit the Commissioner of
10 the Department of Human Resources from requesting a
11 waiver of federal job requirements for able-bodied
12 adults without dependents who are applicants or
13 recipients of the Supplemental Nutritional
14 Assistance Program (SNAP) and would require that
15 the Department of Human Resources ensure that the
16 SNAP program includes all federal work requirements
17 for able-bodied adults without dependents.

19 A BILL
20 TO BE ENTITLED
21 AN ACT

23 To prohibit the Commissioner of the Department of
24 Human Resources from requesting a waiver of federal job
25 requirements for able-bodied adults without dependents who
26 are applicants or recipients of the Supplemental Nutritional
27 Assistance Program (SNAP) and to require that the Department

1 of Human Resources ensure that the SNAP program includes all
2 federal work requirements for able-bodied adults without
3 dependents.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

5 Section 1. The Commissioner of the Department of
6 Human Resources is prohibited from requesting a waiver of
7 federal requirements for able-bodied adults without dependents
8 who are applicants or recipients of the Supplemental
9 Nutritional Assistance Program (SNAP). The Department of
10 Human Resources shall ensure that Alabama's SNAP program
11 includes all federal work requirements for able-bodied adults
12 without dependents.

13 Section 2. This act shall become effective on
14 October 1, 2014.
