22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

23 Section 1. (a) (1) Notwithstanding any other
24 provision of law to the contrary, a public institution of
25 higher education, a local board of education, or any school
26 under the jurisdiction of a local board of education may not

1 expend any public funds from any source for activities to
2 advocate for electors to vote in favor of or against a
3 statewide or local ballot measure, even if it has been
4 determined that the expenditure serves a public purpose.

5 (2) For the purposes of this subsection, the
6 activities prohibited are those enumerated in Section
7 17-17-5(b)(1), Code of Alabama 1975, if the purpose is to
8 advocate for electors to vote in favor of or against a
9 statewide or local measure.

10 (b) Providing information on ballot issues which do
11 not advocate a specific voter action is not a prohibited
12 activity under subsection (a).

13 (c) Nothing in this section shall prevent a
14 contribution or dues payment to a trade association in which
15 the public entity is a member.

16 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
17 first day of the third month following its passage and
18 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
