4 "Sec. 16. Fiscal year 2009-2010 conditional appropriations

5 A. On or before December 15, 2009, the directors of the joint  
6 legislative budget committee and the governor's office of strategic planning  
7 and budgeting shall project the state general fund revenues for fiscal year  
8 2009-2010, which would include all state general fund revenues, not including  
9 the beginning balance, for fiscal year 2009-2010, including one-time revenues  
10 and revenues from any voter-approved temporary additional transaction  
11 privilege tax rate increment.

12 B. If the amount projected pursuant to subsection A of this section  
13 exceeds all budgeted state general fund revenues, not including the beginning  
14 balance, for fiscal year 2009-2010, including one-time revenues, the amount  
15 of the difference shall be appropriated from the state general fund to cities  
16 and towns that receive vehicle license tax monies pursuant to section  
17 28-5808, subsection A, paragraph 2, subdivision (c) and subsection B,  
18 paragraph 2, subdivision (c), Arizona Revised Statutes, and that are required  
19 to distribute a portion of those monies in fiscal year 2009-2010 to local  
20 school districts, distributed based on the cities' and towns' relative  
21 population and not to exceed \$22,000,000.

22 C. On or before December 15, 2009, the directors of the joint  
23 legislative budget committee and the governor's office of strategic planning  
24 and budgeting shall jointly notify the governor, the president of the senate  
25 and the speaker of the house of representatives whether the amount projected  
26 pursuant to subsection A of this section exceeds all budgeted state general  
27 fund revenues, not including the beginning balance, for fiscal year  
28 2009-2010, including one-time revenues and, if so, the total excess amount.

29 D. If the report in subsection C of this section indicates a total  
30 excess amount of revenues, by December 28, 2009, the governor shall issue a  
31 public notice stating the amounts appropriated from the state general fund  
32 for the purposes specified in subsection B of this section.

1           Sec. 17. Reduction in state full-time equivalent employees

2           A. On or before February 1, 2010, the number of full-time equivalent  
3 employees for every general fund supported agency, board, commission or other  
4 entity of this state shall be reduced by five per cent. To meet this  
5 requirement, an agency, board, commission or other entity may not reduce the  
6 hours of or furlough any employee. The reduction may only be made through  
7 reduction of positions.

8           B. Every agency, board, commission or other entity that is required to  
9 reduce full-time equivalent employees pursuant to subsection A shall report  
10 on how the reduction was accomplished to the joint legislative budget  
11 committee on or before June 1, 2010.

12           Sec. 18. Automobile theft authority; reduction; transfer

13           In addition to any other reductions made to the automobile theft  
14 authority's fiscal year 2009-2010 appropriation, the automobile theft  
15 authority fund appropriation to the automobile theft authority is reduced by  
16 \$500,000 in fiscal year 2009-2010 and is transferred to the state general  
17 fund."
