

KAVANAGH SUBSTITUTE FLOOR AMENDMENT
HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO H.B. 2033

I move the following SUBSTITUTE amendment to the JUDICIARY Committee Amendment to
HOUSE BILL 2033 (Reference to printed bill)

- 1 Page 1, line 4, after "procedure" insert ": finding"
- 2 Line 5, after "law" insert "AND EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION B"
- 3 Line 7, strike "FOR THAT OFFICE"
- 4 Between lines 11 and 12, insert:
"B. FOR AN ELECTION FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR AND NOTWITHSTANDING ANY
CHARTER OR ORDINANCE TO THE CONTRARY, IF A CITY OR TOWN DESIGNATES ITS
MAYORAL ELECTIONS AS A GENERAL ELECTION THAT IS FOLLOWED BY A RUNOFF ELECTION
IF THE OFFICE REMAINS UNFILLED AFTER THE CITY OR TOWN'S GENERAL ELECTION, ANY
CANDIDATE WHO RECEIVES A MAJORITY OF ALL VOTES CAST FOR MAYOR AT THE GENERAL
ELECTION SHALL BE DECLARED ELECTED TO THAT OFFICE, AND NO FURTHER ELECTION
SHALL BE HELD AS TO SUCH CANDIDATE, PROVIDED THAT NOTHING ON THE BALLOT SHALL
BE INDICATIVE OF THE SOURCE OF THE CANDIDACY OR OF THE SUPPORT OF THE
CANDIDATE."
- 14 Reletter to conform
- 15 Line 21, strike "B" insert "C"
- 16 After line 23, insert:
"E. THE LEGISLATURE FINDS AND DETERMINES THAT FOR PURPOSES OF ENSURING
CONSISTENCY IN DETERMINING THAT ELECTED MAYORS RECEIVE THE SUPPORT OF A
MAJORITY OF THE VOTING CITIZENRY IT IS A MATTER OF STATEWIDE CONCERN THAT
MAYORAL ELECTIONS THAT INCLUDE A GENERAL ELECTION AND A RUNOFF ELECTION BE
CONDUCTED UNIFORMLY."
