HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO H.B. 2101

(Reference to printed bill)

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:

2 "Section 1. Section 11-211, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 11-211. Membership; qualifications; term; definition

5 A. There shall be in each county having a population of ~~two hundred~~  
6 ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE thousand or more persons a board of supervisors  
7 consisting of five members who shall be qualified electors of their  
8 supervisorial district, and who shall be elected at a general election at  
9 which the president of the United States is elected. In each county having a  
10 population of less than ~~two hundred~~ ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE thousand  
11 persons, a board of supervisors shall consist of three members, except as  
12 prescribed by subsection B OF THIS SECTION, who shall be qualified electors  
13 of their supervisorial district and who shall be elected at a general  
14 election at which the president of the United States is elected. They shall  
15 enter upon their duties on January 1 subsequent to their election, and shall  
16 hold office for four years. No person holding any other county or precinct  
17 office is eligible to the office of supervisor.

18 B. Any county having a population of less than ~~two hundred~~ ONE HUNDRED  
19 SEVENTY-FIVE thousand persons but more than one hundred thousand persons  
20 shall call an election to change from a three-member to a five-member board  
21 of supervisors, or from a five-member to a three-member board of supervisors,  
22 upon receipt by the board of supervisors of a petition ~~signed by not less~~  
23 ~~than~~ CONTAINING SIGNATURES OF QUALIFIED ELECTORS EQUAL TO AT LEAST ten per  
24 cent of the ~~qualified voters who voted~~ VOTES CAST IN THE COUNTY at the  
25 preceding general election at which a president of the United States was  
26 elected. The board shall submit to the electors in such county, at a special  
27 election called for such purpose, the question whether or not such county  
28 shall elect five members or three members to the board of supervisors. The  
29 election shall be held before the first Monday in January preceding the next  
30 general election. The ballots shall contain the words: "Five supervisors,  
31 yes. Five supervisors, no." or "Three supervisors, yes. Three supervisors,

1 no." If the majority of the qualified electors voting on the question ~~vote~~  
2 **VOTES** in the affirmative, the board of supervisors shall redistrict the  
3 county in accordance with ~~the provisions of~~ section 11-212. The county shall  
4 thereafter elect the prescribed number of members to the board of supervisors  
5 who shall have the same qualifications as provided in subsection A **OF THIS**  
6 **SECTION** for a board of supervisors with a population of ~~two hundred~~ **ONE**  
7 **HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE** thousand or more persons, and shall hold office for a  
8 term of four years to commence on January 1.

9 Sec. 2. Applicability

10 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, on the effective date of  
11 this act, a county, with any existing board of supervisors consisting of  
12 three members, that exceeded a population of one hundred seventy-five  
13 thousand persons according to the 2000 United States decennial census shall  
14 begin the process of electing two additional supervisors at the next general  
15 election after the effective date of this act. The board of supervisors of  
16 these counties shall form five supervisorial districts within the county by  
17 adopting the boundaries of the five precinct boundaries for the election of  
18 community college district governing board members pursuant to section  
19 15-1441, Arizona Revised Statutes. The three existing board of supervisors  
20 shall represent the newly formed supervisorial districts based on their  
21 residency. The remaining supervisorial districts shall be filled at the next  
22 general election after the effective date of this act. The terms of the two  
23 newly elected board of supervisors begin on January 1 following the general  
24 election and are for a term of two years. Thereafter, the five supervisorial  
25 districts shall be divided as provided by section 11-212, Arizona Revised  
26 Statutes."
