## **FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION**

---

**The Tibshraeny floor amendment to HB 2282 removes language requiring ADOA to provide cross-links to contracts on the state transparency website and replaces it with a requirement that ADOA provide access to electronic versions of contracts that relate to expenditures.**

**The amendment also adds a legislative intent clause stating that when the technology becomes readily available, the state and local government transparency websites will allow users to cross-link expenditures associated with contracts or subcontracts to the actual language of the contract or subcontract.**
