FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

Allows, with specified requirements and restrictions, an establishment operator or event sponsor to require a person to provide government issued identification in order to establish ownership of a weapon placed in temporary storage.

Removes language relating to the sale or transfer of a firearm on consignment.

Creates an exception for information obtained by law enforcement in the course of an investigation.

- 4 Line 3, after "EVENT" insert ", EXCEPT THAT THE OPERATOR OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OR
- 5 THE SPONSOR OF THE EVENT MAY REQUIRE THAT A PERSON PROVIDE A GOVERNMENT
- 6 ISSUED IDENTIFICATION OR A REASONABLE COPY OF A GOVERNMENT ISSUED
- 7 IDENTIFICATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING OWNERSHIP OF THE WEAPON. THE
- 8 OPERATOR OR SPONSOR SHALL STORE ANY PROVIDED IDENTIFICATION WITH THE WEAPON
- 9 AND SHALL RETURN THE IDENTIFICATION TO THE PERSON WHEN THE WEAPON IS
- 10 RETRIEVED. THE OPERATOR OR SPONSOR SHALL NOT RETAIN RECORDS OR COPIES OF ANY
- 11 IDENTIFICATION PROVIDED PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH AFTER THE WEAPON IS
- 12 RETRIEVED."

- 14 INVESTIGATION,"; after "WHO" insert "PURCHASES,"
- 15 Line 5, strike "PERSON IS" insert "TRANSACTION INVOLVES"

- 17 Line 8, strike "CONSIGNMENT OR"
- 18 Page 5, line 17, strike "F" insert "E"
- 19 Line 18, strike "C" insert "D"
- 20 Amend title to conform
