1 Page 1, line 5, strike ": documentation"

3 Line 7, strike "EACH YEAR"

4 Line 8, after "EDUCATION" insert "OR ITS EQUIVALENT AS PRESCRIBED BY THE BOARD
5 FOR EACH RENEWAL YEAR AND PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION OF COMPLIANCE AT THE TIME OF
6 RENEWAL PURSUANT TO SECTION 32-1642"

7 Line 9, strike "JULY 1, 2011" insert "APRIL 1, 2012"

8 Line 13, after "THE" strike remainder of line

9 Strike line 14, insert "CRITERIA AND CATEGORIES FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION OR
10 EQUIVALENT HOURS TO ASSIST LICENSEES"

11 Strike line 19, insert:

12 "3. THE FORM OF DOCUMENTATION TO BE SUBMITTED AT THE TIME OF RENEWAL
13 TO ESTABLISH COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

14 4. THE EXTENT TO WHICH CONTINUING EDUCATION HOURS MAY BE CARRIED OVER
15 FROM YEAR TO YEAR."

16 Line 26, after "WHO" strike remainder of line

17 Line 27, strike "ADEQUATE CAUSE OR WHO"

18 Strike lines 30, 31 and 32, insert:

19 "F. IN A DISPUTE CONCERNING THE QUALIFICATION OF CONTINUING EDUCATION
20 HOURS TO MEET THE BOARD'S CRITERIA, THE LICENSEE OR CERTIFICATE HOLDER MAY
21 REQUEST AN ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING PURSUANT TO TITLE 41, CHAPTER 6,
22 ARTICLE 10.

1 Sec. 2. Proration of continuing education requirements

2 The state board of nursing shall prorate the continuing education
3 requirements prescribed pursuant to section 32-1641, Arizona Revised
4 Statutes, as added by this act, by one year periods for licenses and
5 certificates that are renewed before April 1, 2015. A licensee who must
6 renew a license on or before April 1, 2012, must have completed twenty hours
7 of continuing education as a condition of license renewal.

8 Sec. 3. Exemption from rule making

9 For the purposes of this act, the state board of nursing is exempt from
10 the rule making requirements of title 41, chapter 6, Arizona Revised
11 Statutes, for one year after the effective date of this act.

12 Sec. 4. Appropriation; state board of nursing; exemption

13 A. The sum of \$164,618 and two FTE positions are appropriated from the
14 board of nursing fund established by section 32-1611, Arizona Revised
15 Statutes, in fiscal year 2011-2012 to the state board of nursing for the
16 purposes of this act.

17 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
18 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
19 lapsing of appropriations."
