SENATE AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1215

(Reference to printed bill)

1 Page 4, line 20, after the period insert “CHIROPRACTIC SERVICES MAY BE PROVIDED
2 WHEN THE PATIENT’S PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN HAS AGREED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE
3 PROGRAM AND REFERRED THE PATIENT FOR CHIROPRACTIC TREATMENT AS PART OF
4 INTEGRATED PAIN MANAGEMENT TREATMENT.”

5 After line 26, insert:

6 “Sec. 3. Integrative therapies pilot program; report; repeal

7 On or before January 1 of each year and through January 1, 2015, the
8 Arizona health care cost containment system administration shall submit to
9 the governor, the president of the Senate and the speaker of the House of
10 Representatives a written report of the effectiveness of the Integrative
11 therapies pilot program on patient health, cost effectiveness within the
12 system, and potential benefits for continuation of the program on a permanent
13 basis. This requirement is repealed after January 1, 2015.
