FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

- Limits the exemption to *baked and confectionary goods* that are prepared in a home for commercial purposes.
- Requires the label of the product to be given to the product's final consumer.
- Requires the label, if the product was prepared in a facility for developmentally disabled individuals, to disclose that fact.
- Requires DHS to establish an on-line registry of exempt food or drink preparers who are exempt from regulation pursuant to this legislation, and requires those preparers to register.
- Requires all of the product's *ingredients*, rather than *contents*, to be disclosed on the label.
- Requires an exempt food or drink preparer to obtain a food handler's card or certificate only if the preparer's local county issues such cards or certificates.
- Defines *potentially hazardous* as products that meet the federal food safety guidelines developed by the United States Food and Drug Administration, which are modified and incorporated by DHS by rule.
- Makes conforming changes.
