FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

1. Allows the county school superintendent to appoint school district governing board vacancies only if the school district governing board grants the superintendent permission to do. However, the superintendent may not call a special election to fill a school district governing board vacancy.
2. Adds that a school district governing board may delegate their authority to fill vacancies to the county school superintendent. The governing board must do so by a formal resolution adopted at a meeting that is open to the public and is subject to the Open Meeting Law
3. Requires a school district governing board to consider all appointments for vacancies and make all appointments at a meeting that is open to the public and is subject to the Open Meeting Law.
4. Prohibits a school district governing board from granting their authority to fill a vacancy by special election to the county school superintendent.
5. Changes the minimum required age for a candidate for county school superintendent from 30 to 25.
6. Adds that a member of a JTED governing board shall not serve simultaneously as a member of any other governing board.
7. Adds that in a county over 500,000 persons, an employee of a member district or of a JTED or the spouse of that employee shall not hold membership on that JTED's governing board.
8. Makes technical and conforming changes.

13 vacancy. The county school superintendent is not required to appoint a
14 governing board member from the list of names submitted by the governing
15 board."
