1 Page 2, line 22, after "G." insert "BEGINNING IN THE FALL SEMESTER OF 2011,"

2 Lines 26 and 27, strike "~~met all of the following requirements:~~" insert "met all
3 ~~of~~ the following requirements:"

4 Between lines 29 and 30, insert:

5 "1. REGISTERED TO VOTE IN THIS STATE."

6 Line 30, strike "~~2.~~" insert "2."

7 Strike line 36

8 Reletter to conform

9 Page 3, after line 9, insert:

10 "Sec. 2. In-state status for honorably discharged veterans of
11 armed forces before fall semester 2011

12 A. Notwithstanding section 15-1802, Arizona Revised Statutes, as
13 amended by this act, for any semester before the start of the fall semester
14 of 2011, a person who is honorably discharged from the armed forces of the
15 United States shall be granted immediate classification as an in-state
16 student on honorable discharge from the armed forces and, while in continuous
17 attendance toward the degree for which currently enrolled, does not lose
18 in-state student classification if the person has met all of the following
19 requirements:

20 1. Declared Arizona as the person's legal residence with the person's
21 branch of service at least one year before discharge from the armed forces.

22 2. Demonstrated objective evidence of intent to be a resident of
23 Arizona which, for the purposes of this section, includes at least one of the
24 following:

- 1 (a) An Arizona driver license.
- 2 (b) Arizona motor vehicle registration.
- 3 (c) Employment history in Arizona.
- 4 (d) Arizona voter registration.
- 5 (e) Transfer of major banking services to Arizona.
- 6 (f) Change of permanent address on all pertinent records.
- 7 (g) Other materials of whatever kind or source relevant to domicile or
- 8 residency status.

9 3. Filed an Arizona income tax return with the department of revenue
10 during the previous tax year.

11 B. Notwithstanding subsection A of this section, for any semester
12 before the start of the fall semester of 2011, a person who was serving at a
13 military installation in this state at the time the person was honorably
14 discharged from any branch of the armed forces of the United States is
15 entitled to immediate classification as an in-state student, without regard
16 to the length of time the person was domiciled in this state.

17 Sec. 3. Emergency

18 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the
19 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by
20 law."
