

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO H.B. 2541

(Reference to House engrossed bill)

1 Page 3, after line 31, insert:

2 "Sec. 4. Subject to the requirements of article IV, part 1, section 1,  
3 Constitution of Arizona, section 36-2807, Arizona Revised Statutes, is  
4 amended to read:

5 **36-2807. Verification system**

6 A. Within one hundred twenty days of the effective date of this  
7 chapter, the department shall establish a secure, password-protected,  
8 web-based verification system for use on a twenty-four hour basis by law  
9 enforcement personnel, ~~and~~ nonprofit medical marijuana dispensary agents **AND**  
**EMPLOYERS** to verify registry identification cards. **AN EMPLOYER MAY USE THE**  
**VERIFICATION SYSTEM ONLY TO VERIFY A REGISTRY IDENTIFICATION CARD THAT IS**  
**PROVIDED TO THE EMPLOYER BY A CURRENT EMPLOYEE OR BY AN APPLICANT WHO HAS**  
**RECEIVED A CONDITIONAL OFFER OF EMPLOYMENT.**

14 B. The verification system must allow law enforcement personnel and  
15 nonprofit medical marijuana dispensary agents to enter a registry  
16 identification number and verify whether the number corresponds with a  
17 current, valid identification card.

18 C. The system shall disclose:

19 1. The name of the cardholder, but must not disclose the cardholder's  
20 address.

21 2. The amount of marijuana that each registered qualifying patient  
22 received from nonprofit medical marijuana dispensaries during the past sixty  
23 days.

24 D. The verification system must include the following data security  
25 features:

1           1. Any time an authorized user enters five invalid registry  
2         identification numbers within five minutes, that user cannot log in to the  
3         system again for ten minutes.

4           2. A users log-in information shall be deactivated after ~~5~~ **FIVE**  
5         incorrect login attempts until the authorized user contacts the department  
6         and verifies ~~his~~ THE USER'S identity.

7           3. The server must reject any log-in request that is not over an  
8         encrypted connection.

9           Sec. 5. Retroactivity

10          This act applies retroactively to from and after April 12, 2011.

11          Sec. 6. Requirements for enactment: three-fourths vote

12          Pursuant to article IV, part 1, section 1, Constitution of Arizona,  
13         section 36-2807, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by this act, is  
14         effective only on the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the  
15         members of each house of the legislature."
