1 Page 1, strike lines 13 through 37, insert:

2 "C. THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER SCHOOL MAY ESTABLISH A DROPOUT
3 RECOVERY FUND TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR THE PROGRAM. THE SCHOOL
4 DISTRICT OR CHARTER SCHOOL MAY CLAIM UP TO 1.0 AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP
5 THROUGH THE STATE EQUALIZATION FUNDING FORMULA FOR EACH PUPIL PARTICIPATING
6 IN THE DROPOUT RECOVERY PROGRAM ON A FULL-TIME BASIS. THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR
7 CHARTER SCHOOL MAY CLAIM UP TO 1.0 AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP THROUGH THE STATE
8 EQUALIZATION FUNDING FORMULA FOR EACH PUPIL WHO ATTENDS BOTH THAT SCHOOL
9 DISTRICT'S DROPOUT RECOVERY PROGRAM AND ANOTHER SCHOOL DISTRICT'S DROPOUT
10 RECOVERY PROGRAM DURING THE SAME FISCAL YEAR. THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER
11 SCHOOL MAY CLAIM A PROPORTIONATELY REDUCED AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP THROUGH
12 THE STATE EQUALIZATION FUNDING FORMULA FOR EACH PUPIL PARTICIPATING IN THE
13 DROPOUT RECOVERY PROGRAM ON A LESS THAN FULL-TIME BASIS. THE AVERAGE DAILY
14 MEMBERSHIP FOR EACH PARTICIPATING PUPIL SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED IN ACCORDANCE
15 WITH THE APPORTIONMENT SCHEDULE PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 15-973. THE SCHOOL
16 DISTRICT SHALL DEPOSIT THESE PAYMENTS INTO THE DROPOUT RECOVERY FUND."
