FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

- Adds sexual offenses to the dismissed criminal charges that require notice to the prosecuting agency.
- Removes denied civil commitment orders from the notification requirement.
- Shortens the notice mailing requirement timeframe from 10 days to 5 days.
- Makes technical and conforming changes.
