KLEIN FLOOR AMENDMENT

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1433

(Reference to printed bill)

1 Page 1, line 27, after "ORDERS" insert ", INCLUDING FEDERAL STATUTES, MANDATES AND
2 EXECUTIVE ORDERS ENACTED BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION,"

3 Strike lines 28, 29 and 30

4 Page 4, strike lines 5 through 9, insert:

5 "8. We acknowledge that the "Commerce Clause", the "General Welfare
6 Clause" and the "Necessary and Proper Clause" of the United States
7 Constitution were amended, and made more specific by limiting the peoples'
8 insistence through the creation of the Bill of Rights, in particular the
9 Second Amendment, the Ninth Amendment and the Tenth Amendment. All amendments
10 within the Bill of Rights were for the purpose of further restricting federal
11 powers, vesting or retaining the ultimate power and control of the states by
12 the people within the states. Therefore, we specifically reject and deny any
13 federal claim of expanded or additional authority, which the federal
14 government may from time to time attempt to exert, exercise or enforce under
15 these clauses.

16 Further, the people of the State of Arizona are aware that the federal
17 government has amended and altered the spirit and the meaning of the
18 "Commerce Clause", all without proper legislative authority through
19 amendment. Therefore, we reject and deny this unauthorized and excessive
20 abuse of power, which has primarily acted as a detriment to states' rights
21 and individual rights."
