FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

- 1) Excludes the following from the calculation of the appropriations limit:
 - Repayment of state debt (including rollovers);
 - Deposits to the Budget Stabilization Fund;
 - Deposits to a State Emergency Fund; and
 - Refunds of excess state revenues to taxpayers.
- 2) Reinstutes the ability to adjust the appropriation limit when functions are transferred from one level of government to another.

1 Page 3, between lines 6 and 7, insert:

2 "4. REPAYMENT OF ANY OBLIGATIONS OF THIS STATE OR OF ANY DEPARTMENT,
3 OFFICE, AGENCY, COMMISSION, BOARD OR OTHER INSTRUMENTALITY OF STATE
4 GOVERNMENT.

5 5. REPAYMENT OF ANY OBLIGATION FOR THE RESTORATION OF PAYMENTS DEFERRED
6 FROM ONE FISCAL YEAR TO ANOTHER.

7 F. ANY APPROPRIATIONS LISTED IN SUBSECTION E OF THIS SECTION ARE
8 EXCLUDED FROM THE CALCULATION OF THE APPROPRIATION LIMIT UNDER SUBSECTION C
9 OF THIS SECTION."

13 "④ I. In order to permit the transference of governmental functions
14 or funding responsibilities between the federal and state governments and
15 between the state government and its political subdivisions without abridging
16 the purpose of this section to limit state appropriations ~~to a percentage of~~
17 ~~total personal income~~, the legislature shall provide for adjustments of the
18 appropriation ~~percentage~~ limitation consistent with the following principles:

19 ① 1. If the federal government assumes all or any part of the cost of
20 providing a governmental function which the state previously funded in whole
21 or in part, the appropriation limitation shall be commensurately decreased.

22 ② 2. If the federal government requires the state to assume all or
23 any part of the cost of providing a governmental function the appropriation
24 limitation shall be commensurately increased.

25 ③ 3. If the state assumes all or any part of the cost of providing a
26 governmental function and the state requires the political subdivision, which
27 previously funded all or any part of the cost of the function to

1 commensurately decrease its tax revenues, the appropriation ~~percentage~~
2 limitation shall be commensurately increased.

3 ~~(d)~~ 4. If a political subdivision assumes all or any part of the cost
4 of providing a governmental function previously funded in whole or in part by
5 the state, the appropriation ~~percentage~~ limitation shall be commensurately
6 decreased.

7 Any adjustments made pursuant to this subsection shall be made for the
8 first fiscal year of the assumption of the cost. Such adjustment shall remain
9 in effect for each subsequent fiscal year."
