1 Page 3, line 6, strike "IMPRESS A LIEN ON"

2 Strike lines 7 and 8, insert "ESTABLISH A CONSTRUCTIVE TRUST ON THE PROPERTY OR
3 THE ESTATE OF THE KILLER, EFFECTIVE FROM THE TIME OF THE KILLER'S ACT THAT
4 CAUSED THE DEATH, IN ORDER TO SECURE THE PAYMENT OF ALL DAMAGES AND JUDGMENTS
5 FROM CONDUCT THAT, PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION F OF THIS SECTION, RESULTED IN
6 CRIMINAL"

7 Line 15, strike "HOMICIDE AS DEFINED IN SECTION"

8 Strike lines 16, 17 and 18, insert "CONVICTION OR A FINDING OF GUILTY EXCEPT
9 INSANE FOR A HOMICIDE PURSUANT TO SECTION 13-1103, 13-1104 OR 13-1105."

10 After line 27, insert:

11 "Sec. 2. Applicability

12 Section 14-2803, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by this act,
13 applies to crimes committed before the effective date of this act."
