HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO H.B. 2825

(Reference to printed bill)

- 1 Page 1, line 8, strike "TO A CONSUMER FOR" insert "EXCEEDING FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS
- 2 TO A CONSUMER FOR AN INITIAL PAYMENT OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS OR GREATER,"
- 3 After line 45, insert:
 - 4 "4. "INITIAL PAYMENT" MEANS THE TOTAL AMOUNT THE PURCHASER BECOMES
 - 5 OBLIGATED TO PAY TO THE SELLER OR TO ANY THIRD PARTY FOR GOODS, SERVICES OR
 - 6 MERCANDISE RELATED TO A PREVIOUSLY PURCHASED BUSINESS OPPORTUNITY, EITHER
 - 7 PRIOR TO OR AT THE TIME OF THE DELIVERY OF ANY GOODS, SERVICES OR MERCANDISE
 - 8 WITHIN SIX MONTHS AFTER THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE OPERATION OF THE BUSINESS
 - 9 OPPORTUNITY BY THE PURCHASER. IF PAYMENT IS OVER A PERIOD OF TIME, "PAYMENT"
 - 10 SHALL INCLUDE THE SUM OF THE DOWN PAYMENT AND THE TOTAL PERIODIC PAYMENTS."
- 11 Renumber to conform
- 12 Page 15, strike line 33; line 34, strike "ATTACHMENTS" insert:
 - 13 "4. WITH REFERRAL"
- 14 Amend title to conform
