SENATE AMENDMENTS TO H.B. 2826  
(Reference to House engrossed bill)

1 Page 2, line 8, strike "AN" insert "A CANDIDATE"

2 Line 26, after the period strike remainder of line

3 Strike lines 27 and 28, insert:

4 "F. BEGINNING WITH ELECTIONS HELD IN 2014 AND LATER THAT ARE NOT  
5 CANDIDATE ELECTIONS, AN ELECTION HELD FOR OR ON BEHALF OF ANY POLITICAL  
6 SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE OTHER THAN A SPECIAL ELECTION MAY ONLY BE HELD ON  
7 THE FOLLOWING DATES:

8 1. THE SECOND TUESDAY IN MARCH.

9 2. THE THIRD TUESDAY IN MAY.

10 3. THE TENTH TUESDAY BEFORE THE FIRST TUESDAY AFTER THE FIRST MONDAY  
11 IN NOVEMBER.

12 4. THE FIRST TUESDAY AFTER THE FIRST MONDAY IN NOVEMBER.  
13 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, AN ELECTION MUST BE HELD ON THIS DATE FOR THE  
14 APPROVAL OF AN OBLIGATION OR OTHER AUTHORIZATION REQUIRING OR AUTHORIZING THE  
15 ASSESSMENT OF SECONDARY PROPERTY TAXES BY A COUNTY, CITY, TOWN, SCHOOL  
16 DISTRICT, COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT OR SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT, EXCEPT AS  
17 PROVIDED BY TITLE 48.

18 G. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, FOR A JURISDICTIONAL ELECTION  
19 ADMINISTERED BY A COUNTY OFFICER IN CHARGE OF ELECTIONS AND FOR WHICH AN ALL  
20 MAIL BALLOT ELECTION WOULD OTHERWISE BE ADMINISTERED, THE COUNTY RECORDER OR  
21 OTHER OFFICER IN CHARGE OF ELECTIONS MAY USE A UNIFIED BALLOT FORMAT AND MAY  
22 ADMINISTRATIVELY COMBINE OR SHARE COUNTY AND JURISDICTIONAL POLLING PLACES,  
23 PRECINCTS AND ELECTION BOARDS."
