FACT SHEET FOR S.B. 1156

historic names board; membership

Purpose

Modifies the name of an agency who appoints a member to the State Board on Geographic and Historic names.

Background

According to statute, it is the declared public policy of the state that natural or artificial objects, places or things continue to be known by the names they presently bear, as determined by the state geographic and historic names board, so that the historical record of Arizona may be protected and preserved. (A.R.S. § 41-835)

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the state General Fund associated with this measure.

Provisions

1. Changes department of commerce to Arizona Commerce Authority.
2. Becomes effective on the general effective date.
