FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

The Griffin floor amendment removes the 10 mile radius written notification requirement and instead requires written notification to those lands contiguous with the treatment area and further requires general publication in a daily or weekly newspaper within the general application area.

Additionally, the amendment excludes applications which require a federally issued Incidental Take Permit and occurs in either a reservoir with a capacity of at least 10,000 acre feet or to the Colorado River below and including Lake Mead.

1 Page 1, line 19, after "LANDS" strike remainder of line, insert "THAT ARE
2 CONTIGUOUS WITH THE TREATMENT AREA AS DEFINED IN THE IMPACT ANALYSIS AND
3 PUBLISH GENERAL NOTICE IN TWO PUBLICATIONS IN A DAILY OR WEEKLY NEWSPAPER OF
4 GENERAL CIRCULATION WITHIN THE GENERAL AREA IN WHICH THE ROTENONE OR
5 ANTIMYCIN A WILL BE APPLIED."

6 After line 26 insert:

7 "C. THIS ARTICLE DOES NOT APPLY WHEN THE APPLICATION IS BOTH:

8 1. TO A RESERVOIR, OR TO A WATER BODY FOR PURPOSES OF OPERATING A
9 RESERVOIR OR DELIVERING WATER FROM A RESERVOIR OR SYSTEM OF RESERVOIRS, THAT
10 HAS A CAPACITY OF AT LEAST TEN THOUSAND ACRE FEET, OR TO THE COLORADO RIVER
11 BELOW AND INCLUDING LAKE MEAD.

12 2. PURSUANT TO A FEDERALLY-ISSUED INCIDENTAL TAKE PERMIT PURSUANT TO
13 THE FEDERAL ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT."
