FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

The Biggs floor amendment to S.B. 1524 does the following:

Changes the administration of the Department of Corrections (DOC) Building Renewal Fund (Fund) from Arizona Department of Administration (ADOA) to DOC.

Requires a monthly report from DOC to the JLBC staff on the status of the building renewal projects and prohibits the monies from being used for any other purpose.

Makes adjustments to the appropriations from the State Highway Fund (SHF) to the Arizona Department of Transportation to compensate for the Feed Bill's use of SHF monies for MVD operating expenses.

Appropriates \$20,000,000 in FY 2013 and \$30,000,000 to in FY 2014 to ADOA for the construction of 500 maximum security prison beds, and requires JCCR review.
