FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

The Crandell Floor Amendment does the following:

- Removes *public* so the bill applies to occupational health, health or safety audits;
- Modifies the part of the audit report a state agency employee may use and agreements that do not waive privilege; and
- Removes the affirmative defense and criminal sanctions to disclosure by state employees, but adds a civil penalty instead.
