6 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
7 the legislature continues the water infrastructure finance authority to
8 provide a source of financing and technical assistance for capital projects
9 for water treatment and water supply development, including applying for and
10 acquiring any federal financial assistance that is available and to enhance
11 security for authority financial and technical assistance.

12 Sec. 7. Purpose

13 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
14 the legislature continues the department of environmental quality to
15 consolidate and focus responsibility for environmental management and
16 administration of water quality, air quality, solid waste and hazardous waste
17 regulation with the goal of increasing effectiveness, efficiency and public
18 acceptance of environmental regulation.

20 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
21 the legislature continues the Arizona historical society to purchase,
22 receive, hold, lease and sell property for the benefit of this state and the
23 use of the society.

25 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
26 the legislature continues the board of physical therapy to promote the safe
27 and professional practice of physical therapy in this state.

28 Sec. 10. Purpose

29 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
30 the legislature continues the department of financial institutions to promote
31 the public welfare by protecting the financial assets of the citizens of this
32 state through the administration of this state's statutes that relate to
33 financial institutions and enterprises.

1 Sec. 11. Purpose

2 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 the legislature continues the registrar of contractors agency to protect the
4 public health, safety and welfare by licensing, bonding and regulating
5 contractors engaged in construction and by administering the contractors'
6 recovery fund.

7 Sec. 12. Purpose

8 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
9 the legislature continues the board of cosmetology to ensure that the public
10 is protected from the incompetent practice of cosmetology by establishing
11 minimum qualifications for entry into the profession and swift and effective
12 discipline for those practitioners who violate cosmetology statutes or rules
13 adopted pursuant to those statutes."
