The Worsley Floor Amendment adjusts the fees for filing partnership documents with the Secretary of State's office to reflect allowable transactions.

1 Page 23, between lines 2 and 3, insert:

2 “Sec. 42. Section 29-366, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to

4 29-366. Fees

5 The secretary of state shall charge and collect in advance and deposit,
6 pursuant to sections 35-146 and 35-147, in the state general fund the
7 following fees:

8 1. Filing a certificate of limited partnership, ten dollars, plus
9 three dollars per page.

10 2. Filing a certificate of amendment **OR ANY DOCUMENT DESCRIBED IN**
11 **CHAPTER 6 OF THIS TITLE**, ten dollars, plus three dollars per page.

12 3. Filing a restated certificate of limited partnership, ten dollars,
13 plus three dollars per page.

14 4. Filing a certificate of cancellation of limited partnership, ten
15 dollars, plus three dollars per page.

16 5. Filing an application for registration as a foreign limited
17 partnership, ten dollars, plus three dollars per page.

18 6. Issuing a certificate of registration to transact business in this
19 state, ten dollars.

20 7. Filing a certificate correcting a statement contained in an
21 application for registration of a foreign limited partnership, ten dollars,
22 plus three dollars per page.

23 8. Filing a certificate of cancellation of the registration of a
24 foreign limited partnership, ten dollars, plus three dollars per page.

25 9. Filing an application for reservation of a name, ten dollars.

26 10. Filing a certificate declaring withdrawal under section 29-320,
27 subsection A, paragraph 2, ten dollars, plus three dollars per page.

Senate Amendments to S.B. 1353

1 11. At time of any service of process upon the secretary of state as
2 agent for service of process, twenty-five dollars, which amount may be
3 recovered as taxable costs by the party to the suit or action causing such
4 service to be made if such party prevails in the suit or action.

5 12. Document certification, five dollars per document."
