FACT SHEET FOR S.B. 1474

used motor vehicle dealer; definition

Purpose

Increases the number of used motor vehicles a person may sell, buy, auction, exchange or offer before they are considered to be a used motor vehicle dealer.

Background

A.R.S. Title 28, Chapter 10, Article 4 outlines the requirements and restrictions for dealers that sell new and used motor vehicle in the state. The definition of used motor vehicle dealer includes those entities that are engaged in the business of selling four or more used vehicles in a 12-month period. Entities that sell new and used motor vehicles are required to be licensed by the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) as dealers.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the state General Fund associated with this legislation.

Provisions

1. Increases from three to six the number of used motor vehicles that a person may buy, sell, auction, exchange, offer or attempt to negotiate a sale or exchange of an interest in, or engage in the business of selling in a continuous twelve month period without a used motor vehicle dealer license.
2. Becomes effective on the general effective date.
