Bill Number: **HB 2058**

Thorpe Floor Amendment

HB 2058 prohibits the state from funding any rule, policy or regulation issued by the federal government unless it has been affirmed by a vote of Congress and signed into law as prescribed by the United States Constitution.

Your 6 line floor amendment to HB 2058 makes the following changes:

- Adds that the prohibition may be waived by a vote of the Legislature if in session or by the Governor, President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House if not in session.
