Farnsworth Floor Amendment

HB 2085 makes changes to the private investigator and security guard statutes in regards to disciplinary actions. Additionally, HB 2085 includes a provision that removes the 3-member quorum requirement for the Private Investigator and Security Guard Hearing Board (Board).

The Farnsworth Floor Amendment to HB 2085 clarifies that a majority of the 7-member Board, regardless of vacancies, constitutes a quorum and a majority vote of the quorum present is necessary for the Board to take any action.
