## FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

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\*Revised\*

HB 2563 redefines terms related to health care institutions subject to licensure by ADHS.

The floor amendment includes in the definition of *health care institution* “nonmedical housing for outpatient treatment centers”.

Defines *nonmedical housing for outpatient treatment centers* as nonmedical housing that is provided by a class of health care institutions that provides physical health services or behavioral health services, including diagnosis and treatment, only at the address of a licensed facility that does not provide inpatient beds and further does not provide physical health services or behavioral health services.

Restores the original language in the exemption section regarding licensure, supervision, regulation or control by ADHS of community education, advocacy or recovery support groups.

24 REGISTRATION FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE DIRECTOR THAT INCLUDES:

- 1           1. THE NAME OF THE SOBER-LIVING HOME.
- 2           2. THE ADDRESS OF THE SOBER-LIVING HOME.
- 3           3. THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION REGARDING THE PROPERTY:
- 4           (a) IF THE PROPERTY IS OWNED, THE OWNER'S NAME, ADDRESS AND CONTACT
- 5 TELEPHONE NUMBER.
- 6           (b) IF THE PROPERTY IS LEASED, A COPY OF THE LEASE THAT STATES THAT
- 7 THE PROPERTY WILL BE USED AS A NONMEDICAL SOBER-LIVING HOME.
- 8           B. THE DIRECTOR MAY ESTABLISH A FILING FEE FOR THE REGISTRATION
- 9 REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION.
- 10           C. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "NONMEDICAL SOBER-LIVING HOME"
- 11 MEANS AN UNLICENSED RESIDENCE IN WHICH INDIVIDUALS ARE LIVING WITH A
- 12 ZERO-TOLERANCE POLICY FOR DRUGS AND ALCOHOL AND THAT PROVIDES ACCOUNTABILITY
- 13 IN A STABLE, SAFE AND DRUG-FREE ENVIRONMENT."
