Bill Number: **HB 2604**

Cobb Floor Amendment

Representative Cobb,

The substitute floor amendment to HB 2604, as recommended by the Rules attorneys does the following:

1. Specifies that an authorized entity that possesses and makes available epinephrine auto-injectors and its employees, agents and other individuals, a practitioner that prescribes or dispenses epinephrine auto-injectors to an authorized entity, a pharmacist or practitioner that dispenses epinephrine auto-injectors to an authorized entity and an individual or entity that conducts training are immune from professional liability and criminal prosecution.
2. Removes the exemption regarding an authorized entity located in this state and the administration or provision of an epinephrine auto-injector outside this state.
