Representative Cobb,

The substitute floor amendment to HB 2604, as recommended by the Rules attorneys does the following:

- 1. Specifies that an authorized entity that possesses and makes available epinephrine auto-injectors and its employees, agents and other individuals, a practitioner that prescribes or dispenses epinephrine auto-injectors to an authorized entity, a pharmacist or practitioner that dispenses epinephrine auto-injectors to an authorized entity and an individual or entity that conducts training are immune from professional liability and criminal prosecution.
- 2. Removes the exemption regarding an authorized entity located in this state and the administration or provision of an epinephrine auto-injector outside this state.
