SENATE AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1274

1 Page 1, between lines 1 and 2, insert

2           “Section 1. Section 28-332, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4           28-332. Department of transportation jurisdiction: duties:  
5                          divisions

6           A. The exclusive control and jurisdiction over state highways, state  
7 routes, state owned airports and all state owned transportation systems or  
8 modes are vested in the department of transportation.

9           B. The department shall:

10           1. Register motor vehicles and aircraft, license drivers, collect  
11 revenues, enforce motor vehicle and aviation statutes and perform related  
12 functions.

13           2. Do multimodal state transportation planning, cooperate and  
14 coordinate transportation planning with local governments and establish an  
15 annually updated priority program of capital improvements for all  
16 transportation modes.

17           3. Design and construct transportation facilities in accordance with a  
18 priority plan and maintain and operate state highways, state owned airports  
19 and state public transportation systems.

20           4. Investigate new transportation systems and cooperate with and  
21 advise local governments concerning the development and operation of public  
22 transit systems.

23           5. Have administrative jurisdiction of transportation safety programs  
24 and implement them in accordance with applicable law.

25           C. In order to carry out the responsibilities enumerated in subsection  
26 B of this section, the department is organized into the following divisions:

27           1. Motor vehicle.

1           2. Transportation planning.

2           3. Highways.

3           4. Aeronautics.

4           5. Public transit.

5           6. Administrative services.

6           D. The director may do any of the following:

7           1. Establish divisions in addition to those prescribed in subsection  
8 C of this section.

9           2. Reorganize the department.

10          3. Consolidate the department.

11          4. SUBJECT TO TITLE 41, CHAPTERS 6 AND 23 RELATING TO ADMINISTRATIVE  
12 PROCEDURES AND THE PROCUREMENT CODE, ESTABLISH ALTERNATIVE METHODS AND USE  
13 CONTRACTED PRIVATE PERSONS FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND OVERSIGHT OF PROGRAMS,  
14 FUNCTIONS OR PERSONS THAT ARE SUBJECT TO THIS TITLE. THE DIRECTOR MAY ADOPT  
15 RULES FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THIS PARAGRAPH.

16          E. The department shall provide general administrative support,  
17 equipment and office and meeting space to the Arizona international  
18 development authority established by title 41, chapter 45.

19          Sec. 2. Section 28-2051, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

20          28-2051. Application for certificate of title; vision screening  
21                                 test

22          A. A person shall apply to the department on a form prescribed or  
23 authorized by the department for a certificate of title to a motor vehicle,  
24 trailer or semitrailer. The person shall make the application within fifteen  
25 days after the purchase or transfer of the vehicle, trailer or semitrailer  
26 except that a licensed motor vehicle dealer shall make the application within  
27 thirty days after the purchase or transfer. All transferees shall sign the  
28 application, except that one transferee may sign the application if both of  
29 the following apply:

30          1. The application is for the purposes of converting an out-of-state  
31 certificate of title to a certificate of title issued pursuant to this  
32 article.

1           2. The ownership or legal status of the motor vehicle, trailer or  
2 semitrailer does not change.

3           B. The application shall contain:

4           1. The transferee's full name and either the driver license number of  
5 the transferee or a number assigned by the department.

6           2. The transferee's complete residence address.

7           3. A brief description of the vehicle to be titled.

8           4. The name of the manufacturer of the vehicle.

9           5. The serial number of the vehicle.

10          6. The last license plate number if applicable and if known and the  
11 state in which the license plate number was issued.

12          7. If the application is for a certificate of title to a new vehicle,  
13 the date of sale by the manufacturer or dealer to the person first operating  
14 the vehicle.

15          8. If the application is in the name of a lessor:

16           (a) The lessor shown on the application as the owner or transferee.

17           (b) At the option of the lessor, the lessee shown on the application  
18 as the registrant.

19           (c) The address of either the lessor or lessee.

20           (d) The signature of the lessor.

21          9. If the application is for a certificate of title to a specially  
22 constructed, reconstructed or foreign vehicle, a statement of that fact. For  
23 the purposes of this paragraph, "specially constructed vehicle" means a  
24 vehicle not originally constructed under a distinctive name, make, model or  
25 type by a generally recognized manufacturer of vehicles.

26          10. If an applicant rents or intends to rent the vehicle without a  
27 driver, a statement of that fact.

28          11. Other information required by the department.

29          C. Unless subsection B, paragraph 8 of this section applies, on  
30 request of an applicant, the department shall allow the applicant to provide  
31 on the title of a motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer a post office box  
32 address that is regularly used by the applicant.

1           D. A person shall submit the following information with an application  
2 for a certificate of title:

3           1. To a vehicle previously registered:

4           (a) The odometer mileage disclosure statement prescribed by section  
5 28-2058.

6           (b) If the applicant is applying for title pursuant to section  
7 28-2060, the applicant's statement of the odometer reading as of the date of  
8 application.

9           2. To a new vehicle:

10          (a) **EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:**

11          (i) A certificate or electronic title from the manufacturer showing  
12 the date of sale to the dealer or person first receiving the vehicle from the  
13 manufacturer. Before the department issues a certificate of title to a new  
14 vehicle, a certificate or electronic title from the manufacturer shall be  
15 surrendered to the department.

16          (ii) **OTHER DOCUMENTATION AS APPROVED BY THE DIRECTOR SHOWING THAT THE  
17 DATE OF SALE TO THE DEALER OR PERSON FIRST RECEIVING THE VEHICLE FROM THE  
18 MANUFACTURER.**

19          (b) The name of the dealer or person.

20          (c) A description sufficient to identify the vehicle.

21          (d) A statement certifying that the vehicle was new when sold.

22          (e) If sold through a dealer, a statement by the dealer certifying  
23 that the vehicle was new when sold to the applicant.

24          E. The department may request that an applicant who appears in person  
25 for a certificate of title of a motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer  
26 satisfactorily complete the vision screening test prescribed by the  
27 department."
