FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

The Kern Floor Amendment:

- Specifies that the grocery store consist of 4,500 square feet of space covered by a roof.
- Allows the issuance of a spirituous liquor license if the application for the license meets the prescribed conditions and includes a design plan for the premises to be licensed.
- Limits the grocery store liquor sales to 40 percent of the annual gross revenue sales, rather than 60 percent.
- Specifies that if the director determines that the primary purpose of the grocery store is to sell spirituous liquor, the director may require the applicant to submit a revised design plan and require that the applicant derive 40 percent of its annual gross revenue from the sale of spirituous liquor at the premises.
- Specifies that if the grocery store is not in compliance with the 40 percent limit of spirituous liquor sales, the director may suspend or revoke the spirituous liquor license until the grocery store is in compliance with the limit.

4 "6. A GROCERY STORE THAT MEETS THE CONDITIONS PRESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION
5 B, PARAGRAPH 7 OF THIS SECTION MAY BE ISSUED A SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR LICENSE IF
6 THE APPLICATION FOR THE LICENSE INCLUDES A DESIGN PLAN FOR THE PREMISES TO BE
7 LICENSED. IF THE DIRECTOR DETERMINES THAT THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THE GROCERY
8 STORE IS TO SELL SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR, THE DIRECTOR MAY REQUIRE THE APPLICANT TO
9 SUBMIT A REVISED DESIGN PLAN AND REQUIRE THAT THE APPLICANT DERIVE NOT MORE
10 THAN FORTY PERCENT OF ITS ANNUAL GROSS REVENUE FROM THE SALE OF SPIRITUOUS
11 LIQUOR AT THE PREMISES. THE DIRECTOR MAY CONDUCT RANDOM AUDITS OF THE
12 GROCERY STORE TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THE GROSS REVENUE REQUIREMENT
13 PRESCRIBED IN THIS PARAGRAPH. IF THE GROCERY STORE FAILS TO MAINTAIN
14 COMPLIANCE WITH THE GROSS REVENUE REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED IN THIS PARAGRAPH,
15 THE DIRECTOR MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR LICENSE UNTIL THE
16 GROCERY STORE COMPLIES WITH THE GROSS REVENUE REQUIREMENT PRESCRIBED IN THIS
17 PARAGRAPH. THE GROCERY STORE IS OTHERWISE SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF
18 PARAGRAPHS 1, 2, 3 AND 5 OF THIS SUBSECTION."
