

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO H.B. 2390

(Reference to proposed amendment dated: 3/15/16; 4:30 PM)

1 Page 1, line 2, after the first semicolon, insert "powers and"

2 Line 6, strike "Three members" insert "One member"; strike "are" insert "is"

3 Line 7, after "representatives" strike remainder of line

4 Strike line 8

5 Line 9, strike "representatives shall designate one of these members to serve"

6 insert "and who serves"

7 Line 11, strike "Three members" insert "One member"; strike "are" insert "is"

8 Line 12, after "senate" strike remainder of line

9 Strike line 13

10 Line 14, strike "serve" insert "and who serves"

11 After line 23, insert:

12 "6. One member who is affiliated with a statewide civil liberties
13 organization that has a background in civil asset forfeiture and who is
14 appointed by the governor.

15 7. One member who is a criminal defense attorney that has a background
16 in civil asset forfeiture and who is appointed by the governor.

17 8. One member who is a resident of this state and has a background in
18 civil asset forfeiture and who is appointed by the governor.

19 9. The attorney general or the attorney general's designee."

20 Page 2, between lines 5 and 6, insert:

21 "D. The civil forfeiture study committee may:

22 1. Request information, data and reports from any county or state
23 agency or political subdivision of this state. If possible, information shall
24 be provided electronically.

1 2. Hold hearings, conduct fact finding tours and take testimony from
2 witnesses who may assist the committee in fulfilling its responsibilities.”

3 Reletter to conform

4 Page 2, between lines 9 and 10, insert:

5 “F. The legislature shall provide staff and support services to the
6 study committee.”

8 Amend title to conform

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
