5        "Sec. 2. Legislative intent

6            It is the legislature's intent that any amendment to section 28-7902,  
7            Arizona Revised Statutes, that is effective from and after the effective  
8            date of this act and that results in the authorization of additional areas  
9            to allow electronic outdoor advertising as described in section 28-7902,  
10          Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by this act, will result in all of the  
11          following:

12            1. Persons providing electronic outdoor advertising will make all  
13            commercially reasonable efforts to use modern and state of the art  
14            technology.

15            2. The additional areas will not contribute to a collective net  
16            increase of artificial sky glow in this state resulting from electronic  
17            outdoor advertising.

18            3. To the extent possible, commercially reasonable efforts will be  
19            made to replace existing electronic outdoor advertising and the components  
20            of existing electronic outdoor advertising with new and advanced technology  
21            to decrease the artificial sky glow."
