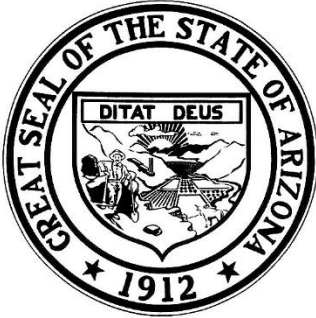


HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION



Bill Number: **SB 1466**

Mesnard Floor Amendment

1. Removes language allowing:
 - a. A county recorder or other officer in charge of elections to continue to operate early voting locations during the three-day period preceding the election, if precinct registers and other elections materials are able to be revised in a timely manner for use on election day;
 - b. A voting center to be used as a ballot replacement location; and
 - c. An elector to obtain a replacement ballot on presentation of a signed, sworn statement that the ballot was *not cast*, rather than *lost, spoiled, destroyed or not received*.
2. Removes the requirement for the county recorder or other officer in charge of elections to determine one or more locations, rather than a central location, to obtain a ballot replacement in the appropriate jurisdiction.
3. Stipulates a county recorder may only modify the approved early voting locations *if an actual emergency occurs on election day or during the three-day period preceding the election*.
4. Permits the BOS to directly authorize the use of additional types of voting and determine additional voting locations.
 - o *Currently, the bill permits the BOS to authorize the county recorder or other officer in charge of elections to perform these functions.*
5. Makes technical and conforming changes.
