1 Page 5, line 40, after the period insert "THE GUIDE MUST ALSO PROMINENTLY DISPLAY
2 A LINK TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR'S WEBSITE, OR A RELATED
3 WEBSITE, THAT PROVIDES INFORMATION ON APPEALS OR COMPLAINTS BY CONSUMERS
4 WHO ARE COVERED BY SELF-INSURED PLANS THAT ARE REGULATED BY THE EMPLOYEE
5 RETIREMENT INCOME SECURITY ACT OF 1974 (P.L. 93-406; 88 STAT. 829)."

6 Page 6, line 31, after "PRIVACY" insert "AND PARENTAL CONSENT"

7 Page 7, line 8, strike "TWO" insert "THREE"; after "MEMBERS" insert "OR FAMILY
8 MEMBERS WHO ARE NOT EMPLOYED BY OR CONTRACTED WITH THE STATE AND"

9 Between lines 9 and 10, insert:

10 "5. AT LEAST ONE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS A HOSPITAL THAT PROVIDES
11 INPATIENT BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES."

13 "9. A HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL FROM A STATEWIDE ASSOCIATION
14 REPRESENTING NURSES."

3 THE TEAM MEMBER CONTACTS, INTERVIEWS OR OBTAINS INFORMATION FROM THE FAMILY
4 MEMBER OF A DECEASED PERSON WHO DIED BY SUICIDE."

8 CHILDREN. TO BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES PAID BY THE
9 FUND, AN INDIVIDUAL MUST MEET ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- 10 1. BE EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR YOUNGER.
- 11 2. BE UNINSURED OR UNDERINSURED.
- 12 3. BE REFERRED FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES BY AN EDUCATIONAL
13 INSTITUTION.
- 14 4. HAVE WRITTEN PARENTAL CONSENT TO OBTAIN THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH
15 SERVICES.
- 16 5. RECEIVE THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES BY A LICENSED BEHAVIOR
17 HEALTH PROFESSIONAL WHO IS A CONTRACT PROVIDER.
- 18 6. RECEIVE THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES ON OR OFF SCHOOL GROUNDS.
19 D."

22 "E. THE ADMINISTRATION MAY IMPOSE COST SHARING REQUIREMENTS ON A
23 SLIDING FEE SCALE FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDED BY CONTRACTORS."

1 (c) WHETHER THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDED WERE APPROPRIATE
2 TO MEET THE STUDENT'S NEED.

3 (d) WHETHER THE PARENT IS SATISFIED WITH THE CHOICE OF BEHAVIORAL
4 HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDER.

5 (e) WHETHER THE PARENT INTENDS TO OPT INTO A PROGRAM AGAIN IN THE
6 FOLLOWING SCHOOL YEAR.

7 3. A REQUIREMENT THAT EACH SCHOOL'S WEBSITE CONTAIN A LIST OF
8 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDERS WITH WHOM THE SCHOOL CONTRACTS.

9 B. AT THE END OF EACH SCHOOL YEAR, EACH PARTICIPATING SCHOOL
10 DISTRICT AND CHARTER SCHOOL SHALL REPORT TO THE ADMINISTRATION THE SCHOOL
11 SURVEY RESULTS.

12 C. THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL COMPILE A REPORT BASED ON THE SURVEYS
13 RECEIVED FROM PARTICIPATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND CHARTER SCHOOLS AS WELL AS
14 UTILIZATION DATA FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THE
15 CHILDREN'S BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES FUND ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 36-3436.
16 ON BEFORE DECEMBER 31 EACH YEAR, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PROVIDE THE
17 REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR, THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE
18 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND PROVIDE A COPY OF THE REPORT TO THE SECRETARY
19 OF STATE. THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE AT LEAST ALL OF THE FOLLOWING
20 INFORMATION:

- 21 1. THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS SERVED.
22 2. THE TYPES OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDED.
23 3. THE COSTS OF THE BEHAVIOR HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDED."

3 "Sec. 7. Arizona health care cost containment system;
4 behavioral health survey of schools; report;

6 A. The Arizona health care cost containment system shall conduct a
7 survey of public schools to obtain information regarding the delivery of
8 behavioral health services to students on or off school grounds by licensed
9 behavior health professionals who are contracted providers. The survey
10 shall include all of the following:

11 1. The types of behavioral health professionals providing the
12 services.

13 2. The number of students who received services.

14 3. The most common diagnoses that resulted in the need for services.

15 B. On or before December 31, 2022, the Arizona health care cost
16 containment system shall provide a copy of the result of the survey to the
17 governor, the president of the senate and the speaker of the house of
18 representatives and provide a copy of the report to the secretary of state.

19 C. This section is repealed from and after July 1, 2021."
