

## HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION



Bill Number: **HB 2124**

Udall Floor Amendment

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1. Specifies that a career technical education district (CTED) may operate for less than 180 days per year with the equivalent number of hours of instruction.
  2. Outlines average daily membership (ADM) for students who are enrolled in a CTED and a school district, charter school or community college and who receive instruction during any hour of the day, during any day of the week and at any time.
  3. Prohibits a CTED's ADM from being calculated on the 100th day of instruction.
  4. Specifies that a CTED's ADM is to be calculated by dividing the instructional hours of enrollment by 600 hours.
    - a) Details exceptions to this requirement that are based on the number of instructional hours and the location of the CTE program or course.
  5. Makes technical changes.

18 SECTION. AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP SHALL BE CALCULATED BY DIVIDING THE

8           1. AT LEAST ONE HUNDRED FIFTY HOURS AND LESS THAN THREE HUNDRED  
9           HOURS EQUALS 0.25 AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP.

10           2. AT LEAST THREE HUNDRED HOURS AND LESS THAN FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY  
11           HOURS EQUALS 0.5 AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP.

12           3. AT LEAST FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY HOURS AND LESS THAN SIX HUNDRED HOURS  
13           EQUALS 0.75 AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP.

14           4. AT LEAST SIX HUNDRED HOURS EQUALS 1.0 AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP.

20           CALCULATED ON THE ONE HUNDREDTH DAY OF INSTRUCTION FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS  
21           SECTION."

22 Page 10, between lines 36 and 37, insert:

23           "Sec. 3. Section 15-393.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
24           read:

25           15-393.01. Career technical education districts; annual  
26           report; performance and accountability

27           A. The department of education shall include each career technical  
28           education district in the department's annual achievement profiles required  
29           by section 15-241. Subject to approval by the state board of education,  
30           the department of education shall develop specific criteria applicable to  
31           career technical education districts that may not be based solely on the  
32           criteria prescribed in the Carl D. Perkins vocational education act, as

1 amended by the Carl D. Perkins vocational and applied technology education  
2 act amendments of 1990, as amended by the Carl D. Perkins vocational and  
3 technical education act of 1998, and shall include career technical  
4 education districts in the letter grade classification system prescribed in  
5 section 15-241. The department shall include all of the following  
6 performance indicators in the annual achievement profiles and letter grade  
7 classification and provide a copy of the information to each career  
8 technical education district governing board:

9 1. The graduation rate of all students enrolled in a career and  
10 technical education program or course.

11 2. The completion rate for each program offered by the career  
12 technical education district.

13 3. Performance on assessments required pursuant to section 15-391,  
14 paragraph 4, subdivision (b).

15 4. Postgraduation employment rates, postsecondary enrollment rates  
16 and military service rates for students who complete a career and technical  
17 education program.

18 B. A career technical education district is subject to the  
19 performance audits pursuant to section 41-1279.03, subsection A,  
20 paragraph 9. The auditor general shall consider the differences and  
21 applicable laws for a career technical education district when conducting a  
22 performance audit for a career technical education district.

23 C. On or before December 31 of each year, the career and technical  
24 education division of the department of education shall submit a career  
25 technical education district annual report to the governor, the president  
26 of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives and shall  
27 submit a copy of this report to the secretary of state. The career and  
28 technical education division of the department of education shall submit a  
29 copy of this report to the joint legislative budget committee for review.  
30 The annual report shall include the following:

31 1. The average daily membership of each career technical education  
32 district, including the average daily membership of each centralized

1 campus, satellite campus and leased centralized campus as defined in  
2 section 15-393.

3 2. The actual student count of each career technical education  
4 district, including the student count of each centralized campus, satellite  
5 campus and leased centralized campus as defined in section 15-393.

6 3. The programs and corresponding courses offered by each career  
7 technical education district, including the location of each program and  
8 course.

9 4. For each career technical education district based on program or  
10 course location:

11 (a) The student enrollment of each program and corresponding course.

12 (b) The percentage of students who enrolled in the second year of  
13 each program and corresponding course relative to the number of students in  
14 the same cohort who enrolled in the first year of each program and  
15 corresponding course.

16 (c) The percentage of students who completed each program relative  
17 to the number of students in the same cohort who began the program.

18 5. The costs associated with each program offered by the career  
19 technical education district.

20 6. A listing of any programs or courses that were discontinued by  
21 review of the career and technical education division pursuant to section  
22 15-393, subsection ~~V~~ W.

23 7. A listing of any programs or courses that were continued by  
24 review of the career and technical education division pursuant to section  
25 15-393, subsection ~~V~~ W.

26 8. A listing of any programs or courses that were added by the  
27 career and technical education division.

28 9. For applicable school districts, the required maintenance of  
29 effort and how monies were used to supplement and not supplant base year  
30 career and technical education courses, including expenditures related to  
31 personnel, equipment and facilities.

1           10. Any other data or information deemed necessary by the department  
2 of education.

3           D. The office of the auditor general, in consultation with the  
4 department of education, shall develop and establish uniform cost reporting  
5 guidelines, policies and procedures for career technical education district  
6 programs. Any guideline, policy or procedure shall allow for the effective  
7 comparison of cost between career technical education district programs."
