Bill Number: **HB 2296**

Payne Floor Amendment

The floor amendment to HB2296 dated 2/22/2021 at 4:36 pm in Representative Payne's name does the following:

1. Specifies that a person is guilty of aggravated driving or actual physical control while under the influence of intoxication if the person is driving under the influence while driving the wrong way on a controlled access highway or state highway section with a posted speed limit of 50 miles per hour or more;
2. Specifies that if a certain report is not forwarded to ADOT within the time limit requires, then the report cannot be used against the person and their driving privilege is not subject to any penalties unless the violation resulted in serious physical injury or death; and
3. Specifies the test is a chemical blood test and the test would determine blood alcohol concentration.
