Bill Number: **HB 2359**

Kavanagh Floor Amendment

The KAVANAGH floor amendment:

1. Removes the requirement that a voting machine or electronic pollbook be secured with a tamper-evident locking device and specifies that it must be secured in a manner to prevent any unauthorized access.
2. Stipulates that the county must document and verify security procedures regarding access before a voting machine or electronic pollbook is placed into service for an election.
