SENATE AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1183
(Reference to printed bill)

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:

2 "Section. 1. Section 41-1730, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 to read:

4 41-1730. Department of public safety forensics fund; purposes;
5 distributions; annual adjustment

6 A. The department of public safety forensics fund is established.
7 The department shall administer the fund. Monies in the fund are subject
8 to legislative appropriation. The department of public safety forensics
9 fund consists of the following:

10 1. Monies deposited pursuant to section 12-116.01, subsection J.
11 2. Monies deposited pursuant to section 41-2401, subsection D,
12 paragraphs 1 and ~~10~~ 10.

13 3. Surcharge monies deposited pursuant to section 28-3396.
14 4. Monies contributed to the fund from any other source.

15 B. Monies in the department of public safety forensics fund shall be
16 used for the following purposes:

17 1. Purchasing and installing fingerprint identification equipment.
18 2. Operating, maintaining and administering the Arizona automated
19 fingerprint identification system and the system's remote terminals.

20 3. Crime laboratory operations and enhanced services.
21 4. Educating and training forensic scientists who are regularly
22 employed in a crime laboratory.

23 5. Purchasing and maintaining scientific equipment for crime
24 laboratory use.

1 6. Implementing, operating and maintaining deoxyribonucleic acid
2 testing and administering the Arizona deoxyribonucleic acid identification
3 system.

4 C. On a quarterly basis, the department of public safety shall
5 allocate and distribute the monies in the department of public safety
6 forensics fund that are collected pursuant to section 12-116.01 and
7 deposited pursuant to section 41-2401, subsection D, paragraph ~~11~~ 10. The
8 department may use fifty-five percent of the monies for the purposes
9 prescribed in subsection B of this section and shall distribute the
10 remaining monies to political subdivisions that operate a crime laboratory
11 as follows:

- 12 1. Twenty-two percent to the Phoenix police department.
- 13 2. Twelve percent to the Tucson police department.
- 14 3. Seven percent to the Mesa police department.
- 15 4. Four percent to the Scottsdale police department.

16 D. The distribution of monies pursuant to subsection C of this
17 section may be adjusted annually, if appropriate, based on the crime
18 laboratory services provided and the percentage of the state population
19 served by each crime laboratory. The crime laboratory directors of the
20 political subdivisions providing crime laboratory services in this state
21 must agree on the distribution formula and allocation. The minimum
22 allocation for a political subdivision that provides crime laboratory
23 services is four percent.

24 E. For the purposes of subsections C and D of this section, "crime
25 laboratory" means a laboratory that meets all of the following:

- 26 1. Is operated by a political subdivision.
- 27 2. Has at least one regularly employed forensic scientist who holds
28 a minimum of a bachelor's degree in a physical or natural science.
- 29 3. Is registered as an analytical laboratory with the drug
30 enforcement administration of the United States department of justice for
31 the possession of all scheduled controlled substances.

1 Sec. 2. Section 41-2401, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
2 read:

3 41-2401. Criminal justice enhancement fund

4 A. The criminal justice enhancement fund is established consisting
5 of monies collected pursuant to section 12-116.01 and monies available from
6 any other source. The state treasurer shall administer the fund.

7 B. On or before November 1 of each year, each department, agency or
8 office that receives monies pursuant to this section shall provide to the
9 Arizona criminal justice commission a report for the preceding fiscal
10 year. The report shall be in a form prescribed by the Arizona criminal
11 justice commission. The report shall set forth the sources of all monies
12 and all expenditures. The report shall not include any identifying
13 information about specific investigations.

14 C. On or before December 1 of each year, the Arizona criminal
15 justice commission shall compile all reports into a single comprehensive
16 report and shall submit a copy of the comprehensive report to the governor,
17 the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives
18 and the director of the joint legislative budget committee.

19 D. On the first day of each month, the state treasurer shall
20 distribute or deposit:

21 1. ~~19.09~~ 20.81 percent in the department of public safety forensics
22 fund established by section 41-1730.

23 2. ~~1.64~~ 3.57 percent to the department of juvenile corrections for
24 the treatment and rehabilitation of youth who have committed drug-related
25 offenses.

26 3. ~~18.97 percent in the peace officers' training fund established by~~
27 ~~section 41-1825.~~

28 4. ~~3. 3.45 5.18~~ percent in the prosecuting attorneys' advisory
29 council training fund established by section 41-1830.03.

30 5. ~~4. 10.66 12.38~~ percent to the supreme court for the purpose of
31 reducing juvenile crime.

1 **6.** 5. ~~8.29~~ 10.01 percent to the department of public safety for
2 allocation to state and local law enforcement authorities for the following
3 purposes:

4 (a) To enhance projects that are designed to prevent residential and
5 commercial burglaries, to control street crime, including the activities of
6 criminal street gangs, and to locate missing children.

7 (b) To provide support to the Arizona automated fingerprint
8 identification system.

9 (c) Operational costs of the criminal justice information system.

10 **7.** 6. ~~10.66~~ 12.38 percent to the department of law for allocation
11 to county attorneys for the purpose of enhancing prosecutorial efforts.

12 **8.** 7. ~~6.86~~ 8.59 percent to the supreme court for the purpose of
13 enhancing the ability of the courts to process criminal and delinquency
14 cases, orders of protection, injunctions against harassment and any
15 proceeding relating to domestic violence matters, for auditing and
16 investigating persons or entities licensed or certified by the supreme
17 court and for processing judicial discipline cases. Notwithstanding
18 section 12-143, subsection A, the salary of superior court judges pro
19 tempore who are appointed for the purposes provided in this paragraph
20 shall, and the salary of other superior court judges pro tempore who are
21 appointed pursuant to section 12-141 for the purposes provided in this
22 paragraph may, be paid in full by the monies received pursuant to this
23 paragraph.

24 **9.** 8. ~~13.34~~ 15.06 percent to the county sheriffs for the purpose of
25 enhancing county jail facilities and operations, including county jails
26 under the jurisdiction of county jail districts.

27 **10.** 9. ~~1.79~~ 3.52 percent to the Arizona criminal justice
28 commission.

29 **11.** 10. ~~2.62~~ 4.34 percent in the department of public safety
30 forensics fund established by section 41-1730.

31 **12.** 11. ~~2.43~~ 4.16 percent to the supreme court for the purpose of
32 providing drug treatment services to adult probationers through the

1 community punishment program established in title 12, chapter 2,
2 article 11.

3 E. Monies distributed pursuant to subsection D, paragraphs 3,
4 ~~4, 7, 9~~ 6, 8 and ~~11~~ 10 of this section constitute a continuing
5 appropriation. Monies distributed pursuant to subsection D, paragraphs 1,
6 2, ~~5, 8, 10~~ 4, 7, 9 and ~~12~~ 11 of this section are subject to legislative
7 appropriation.

8 F. The portion of the monies for direct operating expenses of the
9 department of public safety in subsection D, paragraph ~~6~~ 5 of this section
10 is subject to legislative appropriation. The remainder of the monies in
11 subsection D, paragraph ~~6~~ 5 of this section, including the portion for
12 local law enforcement, is continuously appropriated.

13 G. The allocation of monies pursuant to subsection D, paragraphs 5,
14 6, 7, ~~AND~~ 8 ~~and~~ 9 of this section shall be made in accordance with rules
15 adopted by the Arizona criminal justice commission pursuant to section
16 41-2405.

17 Sec. 3. Appropriation: peace officers' training fund:
18 exemption

19 A. The sum of \$5,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund
20 in fiscal year 2022-2023 to the peace officers' training fund established
21 by section 41-1825, Arizona Revised Statutes.

22 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
23 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating
24 to lapsing of appropriations."
