

## HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION



Bill Number: **SB 1454**

Chaplik Floor Amendment

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The Floor Amendment to SB 1454 in Representative Chaplik's name, dated June 12, 2023, at 10:36 AM:

- Directs the Arizona State Parks Board (Board) to establish the Arizona Veterans Memorial State Park, and outlines requirements related to location and approval by the Joint Committee on Capital Review.
- Appropriates \$10,000,000 from the State Parks Revenue Fund to the Board to purchase the Arizona Veterans Memorial State Park.
- Removes the General Fund appropriation of \$600,000 and 1 FTE for the Veteran Suicide Prevention Training Pilot Program.
- Makes a technical renumbering change.

CHAPLIK FLOOR AMENDMENT  
HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1454  
(Reference to Senate engrossed bill)

1 Page 1, between lines 1 and 2, insert:

2 "Section 1. Section 5-382, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 5-382. State lake improvement fund; administration; report

5 A. A state lake improvement fund is established. Monies deposited  
6 in the fund shall be used only as provided in this section.

7 B. All monies in the state lake improvement fund are appropriated to  
8 the Arizona state parks board solely for the purposes provided in this  
9 section. Interest earned on monies in the fund shall be credited to the  
10 fund. Monies in the state lake improvement fund are exempt from the  
11 provisions of section 35-190 relating to lapsing of appropriations.

12 C. The Arizona state parks board shall administer the monies in the  
13 fund as follows:

14 1. To fund staff support to plan and administer the state lake  
15 improvement fund in conjunction with other administrative tasks and  
16 recreation plans of the board.

17 2. To fund projects on waters where gasoline powered boats are  
18 permitted and shall be limited to the following:

19 (a) Public launching ramps.

20 (b) Public piers, marinas or marina stadia.

21 (c) Public toilets, sanitation facilities and domestic waters.

22 (d) Public picnic tables and facilities.

23 (e) Public parking areas.

24 (f) Lake construction or improvement.

25 (g) Marking buoys and other safety facilities.

1 (h) Watercraft.

2 (i) Public campgrounds.

3 (j) Acquisition of real and personal property through purchase,  
4 lease, agreement or otherwise for the purpose of providing access to waters  
5 where boating is permitted.

6 (k) Design and engineering projects.

7 D. Projects involving expenditure of monies from such fund may be  
8 accomplished by the Arizona state parks board, by the Arizona game and fish  
9 commission, by the board of supervisors of any county or by the governing  
10 body of a city or town, provided such projects do not interfere with any  
11 vested water rights, or the operation or maintenance of water projects,  
12 including domestic, municipal, irrigation district, drainage district,  
13 flood control district or reclamation projects. The Arizona outdoor  
14 recreation coordinating commission, established by section ~~41-511.25~~  
15 41-518, shall examine applications for eligible projects, determine the  
16 amount of funding, if any, for each project and submit a list of projects,  
17 subject to prior review by the joint committee on capital review, to the  
18 Arizona state parks board for allocation from the fund. The board shall  
19 annually report to the legislature the expenditures made for such projects  
20 in conjunction with the report required by section 41-511.12.

21 E. State lake improvement funds may be used on projects where  
22 matching funds are made available.

23 Sec. 2. Renumber

24 Sections 41-511.25 and 41-511.26, Arizona Revised Statutes, are  
25 renumbered as sections 41-518 and 41-518.01, respectively.

26 Sec. 3. Title 41, chapter 3, article 1.1, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
27 is amended by adding a new section 41-511.25, to read:

28 41-511.25. Arizona veterans memorial state park

29 A. THE ARIZONA STATE PARKS BOARD SHALL ESTABLISH THE ARIZONA  
30 VETERANS MEMORIAL STATE PARK SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

31 1. THE ARIZONA STATE PARKS BOARD PURCHASES THE ARIZONA VETERANS  
32 MEMORIAL STATE PARK SITE PURSUANT TO TITLE 37, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 3.

1           2. THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON CAPITAL REVIEW APPROVES THE DESIGN AND  
2 CONSTRUCTION OF THE MEMORIAL.

3           3. THE SITE PURCHASED PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH 1 OF THIS SUBSECTION IS  
4 LOCATED IN A COUNTY WITH A POPULATION MORE THAN FOUR MILLION PERSONS AND  
5 WITHIN TWO MILES OF A VETERAN'S NATIONAL CEMETERY.

6           B. THE ARIZONA STATE PARKS BOARD MAY ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL  
7 AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO TITLE 11, CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE 3 WITH THE COUNTY IN  
8 WHICH THE PARK IS LOCATED FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND PRESERVATION OF THE  
9 ARIZONA VETERANS MEMORIAL STATE PARK."

10 Renumber to conform

11 Page 1, strike lines 32 through 46, insert:

12           "Sec. 6. Appropriation; Arizona state parks board; reversion

13           A. The sum of \$10,000,000 is appropriated from the state parks  
14 revenue fund established by section 41-511.21, Arizona Revised Statutes, in  
15 fiscal year 2023-2024 to the Arizona state parks board to purchase the  
16 Arizona veterans memorial state park site pursuant to section 41-511.25,  
17 Arizona Revised Statutes, as added by this act.

18           B. All monies appropriated in subsection A of this section remaining  
19 unexpended and unencumbered on July 1, 2025 revert to the state parks  
20 revenue fund."
