Bill Number: **SB 1588**

Payne Floor Amendment

---

The Floor Amendment to SB 1588 in Representative Payne's name, dated June 12, 2023, at 10:25 AM:

- Requires all law enforcement agencies to report annually to the Arizona Peace Officer Standards and Training Board (AZPOST) on the number of sworn peace officers they employ.
- Adds requirements that simulators purchased by local law enforcement agencies with the FY 2024 appropriation must include:
  - An electronic impulse device using a safe electric shock to simulate consequences; and
  - Preloaded curriculum certified by AZPOST and developed with nationally recognized partnerships.

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1588

1 Page 4, between lines 10 and 11, insert:

2 "6. THE NUMBER OF SWORN PEACE OFFICERS EMPLOYED BY THE AGENCY ON  
3 JANUARY 31 OF EACH YEAR. EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL PROVIDE A COPY  
4 OF THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THIS PARAGRAPH TO THE ARIZONA PEACE OFFICER  
5 STANDARDS AND TRAINING BOARD ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 41-1821."

6 Page 8, between lines 19 and 20, insert:

7 "Sec. 4. Laws 2023, chapter 133, section 117 is amended to read:

8 Sec. 117. Appropriations; state treasurer; firearm training  
9 simulators; fiscal year 2023-2024

10 A. The sum of \$1,368,000 is appropriated from the peace officer  
11 training equipment fund established by section 41-1731, Arizona Revised  
12 Statutes, in fiscal year 2023-2024 to the state treasurer for firearm  
13 training simulators. THE FIREARM TRAINING SIMULATORS MUST INCLUDE:

14 1. AN ELECTRONIC IMPULSE DEVICE USING A SAFE ELECTRIC SHOCK TO  
15 SIMULATE CONSEQUENCES DURING SCREEN-BASED SIMULATION TRAINING.

16 2. PRELOADED CURRICULUM AND INTERACTIVE VIRTUAL COURSEWORK THAT IS  
17 CERTIFIED BY THE ARIZONA PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING BOARD  
18 ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 41-1821, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, AND HAS BEEN  
19 DEVELOPED EXCLUSIVELY WITH NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED PARTNERSHIPS.

20 B. The state treasurer shall distribute the monies appropriated in  
21 subsection A of this section in the following amounts to the following  
22 recipients:

23 1. \$300,000 to the Phoenix police department.

24 2. \$300,000 to the Mohave county probation department.
