FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

1. Removes the stipulation that each hospital's compliance with federal hospital price transparency regulations is a *condition of licensure*.
2. Requires each hospital to demonstrate its compliance with federal hospital price transparency regulations to the Department of Health Services (DHS).
3. Subjects any hospital who does not comply with federal hospital price transparency regulations to a civil penalty.
4. Requires, by January 1, 2025, and each year thereafter, DHS to post a report on its public website containing each hospital's level of compliance with federal hospital price transparency regulations.

5 DEPARTMENT, IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT, COMPLIANCE WITH THIS
6 SUBSECTION. A HOSPITAL THAT DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THIS SUBSECTION IS
7 SUBJECT TO CIVIL PENALTIES AS PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 36-431.01.

8 B. ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2025 AND EACH JANUARY 1 THEREAFTER, THE
9 DEPARTMENT SHALL POST A REPORT ON ITS PUBLIC WEBSITE CONTAINING EACH
10 HOSPITAL'S LEVEL OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION A OF
11 THIS SECTION."
