**SUMMARY**

The Public Safety Infrastructure trailer bill provides provisions necessary to implement the 2022 Budget Act as it relates to public safety infrastructure.

**Senate Amendments**

Delete the previous contents and instead include the following statutory change to implement provisions of the 2022 Budget Act related to public safety infrastructure. Specifically, this bill modifies the amount of revenue bonds and notes that the State Public Works Board may issue for local jail facilities that are approved by the Board of State and Community Corrections.
