**Fiscal Impact:** Staff notes ongoing annual costs of approximately \$100 million to CDCR for incarcerated persons' wage increases. (General Fund).

**Committee Amendments:** Delete the requirement that the five year payment plan be sufficient to allow incarcerated persons to spend the maximum monthly canteen draw.
