### **SB 1064 (Laird) - Cannabis: operator and separate premises license types: excessive concentration of licenses**

**Bill Summary:** SB 1064 revises the current licensing framework for retail, distribution, processing and manufacturing of cannabis or cannabis products for commercial cannabis activity by creating a uniform operator license, a revised premises license, as specified, and transforming a cultivation or laboratory license into a unified license by January 1, 2026.

**The following information is revised to reflect amendments  
adopted by the committee on May 16, 2024**

**Fiscal Impact:** Unknown significant costs ranging in the millions of dollars to the Department of Cannabis Control (DCC) to modify its existing cannabis licensing framework (Cannabis Control Fund). Costs would include additional resources for IT system development and licensing data conversion, project management consultant costs, and track and trace software system modifications.

- Delay implementation until January 1, 2028.
- Make other technical and conforming changes.
