**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES AND THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN."**

1 Strike section 6 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Sec. 6. Subsection (b) of section 17a-101 of the 2014 supplement to  
3 the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu  
4 thereof (*Effective October 1, 2014*):

5 (b) The following persons shall be mandated reporters: (1) Any  
6 physician or surgeon licensed under the provisions of chapter 370, (2)  
7 any resident physician or intern in any hospital in this state, whether  
8 or not so licensed, (3) any registered nurse, (4) any licensed practical  
9 nurse, (5) any medical examiner, (6) any dentist, (7) any dental  
10 hygienist, [or] (8) any psychologist, [a] (9) any school employee, as  
11 defined in section 53a-65, (10) social worker, (11) any person who  
12 holds or is issued a coaching permit by the State Board of Education, is  
13 a coach of intramural or interscholastic athletics and is eighteen years  
14 of age or older, (12) any individual who is employed as a coach or

15 director of youth athletics and is eighteen years of age or older, (13)  
16 any individual who is employed as a coach or director of a private  
17 youth sports organization, league or team and is eighteen years of age  
18 or older, (14) any paid administrator, faculty, staff, athletic director,  
19 athletic coach or athletic trainer employed by a public or private  
20 institution of higher education who is eighteen years of age or older,  
21 excluding student employees, (15) any police officer, (16) any juvenile  
22 or adult probation officer, (17) any juvenile or adult parole officer, (18)  
23 any member of the clergy, (19) any pharmacist, (20) any physical  
24 therapist, (21) any optometrist, (22) any chiropractor, (23) any  
25 podiatrist, (24) any mental health professional, [or] (25) any physician  
26 assistant, (26) any person who is a licensed or certified emergency  
27 medical services provider, (27) any person who is a licensed or  
28 certified alcohol and drug counselor, (28) any person who is a licensed  
29 marital and family therapist, (29) any person who is a sexual assault  
30 counselor or a domestic violence counselor, as defined in section  
31 52-146k, (30) any person who is a licensed professional counselor, (31)  
32 any person who is a licensed foster parent, (32) any person paid to care  
33 for a child in any public or private facility, child day care center, group  
34 day care home or family day care home licensed by the state, (33) any  
35 employee of the Department of Children and Families, (34) any  
36 employee of the Department of Public Health who is responsible for  
37 the licensing of child day care centers, group day care homes, family  
38 day care homes or youth camps, (35) any paid youth camp director or  
39 assistant director, (36) the Child Advocate and any employee of the  
40 Office of the Child Advocate, and (37) any family relations counselor,  
41 family relations counselor trainee or family services supervisor  
42 employed by the Judicial Department."
